

Right-of-Way & Easement Process



Right-of-Way:

A right of passage over another person's ground.

Easement:

A legal agreement that allows an individual (company/business) to use another person's property.

- 1 AES Ohio evaluates potential routes and proposes routes that minimize impacts on property owners to the extent practical.
- 2 Once an approximate location for the preferred route has been selected, AES Ohio ROW representatives will contact potentially affected property owners to discuss the location of the preferred route.
- 3 After the preferred route has been discussed with affected landowners, AES Ohio will request an easement from affected landowners outlining where the electric transmission line will be located.

- 4 AES Ohio evaluates potential routes and proposes routes that minimize impacts on property owners to the extent practical.
- 5 Property owners can continue to use the property in any manner which is not inconsistent with the operation and maintenance of the electric transmission line.
